### **DIRECTOR'S NOTES**

No matter how many times you may have seen Fiddler on the Roof, its message is timeless – how does one balance changing with the times and holding onto traditions from the past? The show takes its name from a painting by Marc Chagall entitled "The Fiddler" – indeed the fiddler becomes a metaphor for survival, through tradition and joyfulness, in a life full of uncertainty and imbalance.

Listen carefully to the lyrics in the opening production number, TRADITION. The lyrics set up the strong beliefs of a community that propels this storyline.

"A fiddler on the roof. Sounds crazy, no? But here, in our little village of Anatevka, you might say every one of us is a fiddler on the roof trying to scratch out a pleasant, simple tune without breaking his neck. It isn't easy. You may ask, 'Why do we stay up there if it's so dangerous?' Well, we stay because Anatevka is our home. And how do we keep our balance? That I can tell you in one word: tradition!" – Tevye

"You may ask, 'How did this tradition get started?' I'll tell you! I don't know. But it's a tradition. And because of our traditions, every one of us knows who he is and what God expects him to do." – Tevye

"Traditions, traditions. Without our traditions, our lives would be as shaky as—as—as a fiddler—on the roof!" – Tevye

But ..... the love interests of Tevye's beloved eldest daughters introduce .... change .... and .... the power of love .....

"Our traditions! Nothing must change! Everything is perfect exactly the way it is! .... Our ways are changing all over but here .... " Perchik

"Times are changing, Reb Tevye ... " Motel

"Great changes are about to take place in this country. Tremendous changes. But they can't happen by themselves". Perchik

"The world is changing, Papa." Chava

"No. Some things do not change for us. Some things will never change." Tevye

Parents, rules, traditions, and culture are all things that guide children. However, they must decide and act independently when they've grown into adults. Following that, they are also the ones who are accountable for the consequences of their actions, not their parents. Parents navigate this process with a tremendous amount of grace, acceptance, love and faith.
