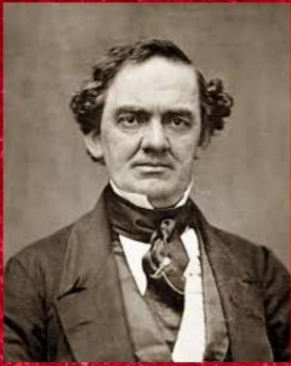

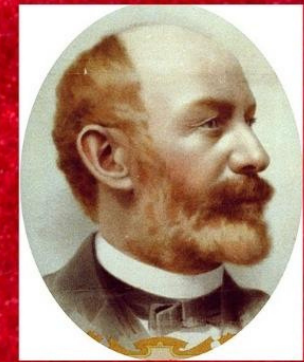

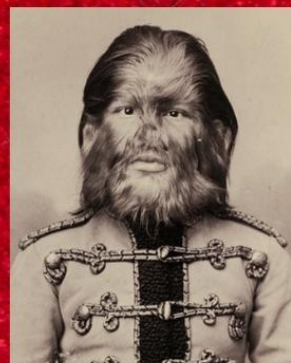

The cast and crew of Big Apple Vignettes used Devised Theatre and Verbatim Theatre to create the show you are about to see. Devised Theatre, also called collective creation, is a method of theatre-making in which the script and performance originates from collaborative, often improvisatory, work by a performing ensemble. Verbatim Theatre is a form of documentary theatre which is based on the spoken words of real people. Strictly, verbatim theatre-makers use real people's words exclusively, and take this testimony from recorded interviews. The students asked friends and family who live(d) in New York City about their experiences, best and worst days, as well as prominent memories and stories. All of which have culminated in the 4-part series you are about to witness. 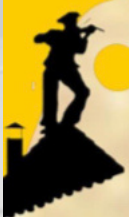
