





MEET THE PRODUCTION TEAM

Elena Ferrante-Martin

As an actress, Elena received her union card from Actor's Equity Association, as well as made her Broadway debut at the age of 23 in the late Tom O'Horgan's Senator Joe. Her favorite credits include Donna in Mamma Mia (Mandalay Bay – Las Vegas), Anita in West Side Story (International and various National Companies), (Outer Critics Circle Winner Best Supporting Actress in a Musical-Pittsburgh, PA), the Spider Woman in Kiss of the Spider Woman (Theatre Works, CA), (Bay Critics Choice Winner Best Actress in a Musical), Adelaide in Guys and Dolls (Desert Inn Las Vegas & Harrah's Atlantic City), Rosie in Bye Bye Birdie (Casa Manana – Texas) and with the original creative team of Frank Galati, Graciela Danielle, Stephen Flaherty and Lynn Ahrens, Ragtime (Original National Touring Company). Most recently, Elena enjoyed her return to the boards as Joanne in Company for the Nevada Conservatory Theatre.

Elena made her transition into education after the birth of her daughter in 2003. Currently, Elena is the Department Chair of Performing Arts, Director of Drama, Vocal Music and the Worship Choir, and founder of Gaels Theatre Guild at Bishop Gorman High School. For Bishop Gorman, Elena has produced and directed Romeo & Juliet, Sound of Music, The Dancer's Story: Alice's Adventures in Wonderland, Little Shop of Horrors, The Dancer's Story: The Wizard of Oz, Thoroughly Modern Millie, The Diary of Anne Frank, The Music Man, Little Women, Lost in Yonkers, Bye Bye Birdie, Into The Woods, The Matchmaker, Oklahoma!, Godspell, Viva Las Vegas Songs from the Strip, Charley's Aunt, Peter Pan, The Importance of Being Earnest, Anything Goes, Arms and the Man, The Mystery of Edwin Drood, Tartuffe, Grease, A Midsummer Night's Dream as well as the Jim3 House of Performing Arts premiere production Seussical the Musical. Ms. Ferrante-Martin is exceedingly dedicated to the vocal/musical theatre program at Bishop Gorman having given birth to Heart and Soul, Gaels on Broadway JV and Varsity, Knight Rhythm, the Worship Choir, the Worship Chamber Musicians, the KnightenGaels, Knight Rhythm, and Directing Practicum - celebrating them all in the Music Extravaganzas and Spectaculars! Elena is honored to have achieved international recognition at the 2015 International Thespian Festival for Lost In Yonkers as well as at the 2011 International Thespian Festival for Godspell and the 2019 Opening Number premiering "Bikini Bottom Day" from SpongeBob SquarePants the Musical. Elena is the recipient of the 2011-2012 Nevada State Theatre Teacher of the Year award as well as the first co-recipient of the prestigious Father Querbes Award at Bishop Gorman High School. Most recently, Elena received Best Direction of a Musical for the State of Nevada with our production of The Sound of Music.

In addition to her directing credits for Bishop Gorman, she has directed professional union productions, which include *Fiddler on the Roof, Babes in Arms, Annie, I Do I Do, My Fair Lady*, and *Brigadoon*.

Elena holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Speech from Northwestern University and a Masters Degree in Secondary Education from Regis University. With her husband, Michael Martin, they have co-produced more than fifty concerts and special events, more than twenty musicals, and two children.

Ms. Lemos has performed, choreographed and directed productions for the Las Vegas Shakespeare Company, the ArtsFrontier Foundation, and Soulfire Studios. She has had the privilege of teaching dance, musical theatre, and Pilates for over 15 years, all around the Las Vegas valley, as well as NYC and California. Louisa has enjoyed being a teaching artist for The Smith Center's Disney Musicals in Schools program, as well as Director for Camp Broadway's Shining Stars and MainStage programs hosted by The Smith Center. Her greatest role, of course, is that of mother to her sweet girls, Calliope Jane and Persephone Rae.

Colt Goodman

From 1970 to 1983 Colt was a professional alpine ski racer and coach. In 1983 he became the Tournament Director for both the Men's and Women's Professional Ski Tours until 1994. The seasonal occupation afforded Colt the opportunity to pursue other passions which were coaching football, acting and stunt work.

Colt loves the old west. He played a cowboy and performed at Knott's Berry Farm in California. His cowboy ways got him jobs in Hollywood. In 1994 Colt earned his Screen Actors Guild card by riding on the hit TV series Doctor Quinn Medicine Woman. Since then, Colt was a stuntman in the movie Volcano. He had a recurring

role in the sitcom Lateline, appeared on the hit reality TV show Pawn Stars, and recently played a gunfighter on the reality TV show Ghost Adventures. Colt is also a Champion Fast Draw and performs his Trick Shooting show around the country.

Today Colt is busier than ever. He and his wife Donna enjoy the old west lifestyle in Sandy Valley by caring for their ranch and 17 rescued animals. Colt is an assistant football and golf coach at Bishop Gorman High School.

David DeDera

Dave has been in the circus arena for the past 30 years. He started his journey at the age of 18 by leaving home in Chicago and attending the Ringling Bros. and Barnum & Bailey Circus Clown College. Upon graduation, Dave traveled and performed with the circus for 6 years becoming the shows Boss Clown. During that time Dave became the skills and clowning instructor at Clown College. This is when Dave realized his love for teaching circus. After leaving Ringling Bros., Dave traveled west to Las Vegas where he quickly became the lead clown at Circus Circus Hotel Casino. He has been there 24 years now. While at Circus Circus Dave found time to perform and tour around the globe with several circuses, as well as The Rolling Stones and most recently DJ Calvin Harris. He has worked as a stunt man in several shows on the Las Vegas strip, and entertained at hundreds of corporate and private events around the world. After teaching at Clown College Dave knew he wanted to continue sharing his talent and knowledge of circus with people. Over his career he has taught circus skills to corporate clients, team building, teacher organizations, Boy Scouts, public schools, and has developed his own Social Circus program, which he uses to teach at risk teens throughout Las Vegas circus skills in order to promote life skills. He coordinates the Cirque du Soleil program, Cirque du Monde, and was the sole instructor for The City of Las Vegas New Directions Youth Arts program. With this program Dave won the National Coming Up Taller Grant from the President of the United States in 2010. He now instructs circus with CirqueKish, a local non for profit giving back to the community. In 2006 Dave and his wife Tonya started their own production company, Stilt Art & Entertainment, specializing in corporate and private event entertainment. Dave holds a degree in graphic arts and now uses his artistic flare to design and build costumes and stage props. Dave is thrilled to be asked back to work with the Bishop Gorman theatre department once again!




